Policy for Award of Non-Government Scholarships and Free-ships in the Form of Fee Concession

1. Objective:

To provide financial relief to deserving students by offering Non-Government Scholarships and Free-ships in the form of fee concessions, ensuring that no student is denied education due to financial constraints.

2. Eligibility Criteria:

- a. The applicant must be a regular, full-time student of RCPET's R. C. Patel Arts, Commerce, and Science College, Shirpur.
- b. The student must have demonstrated academic excellence, with a minimum 60% of marks in H.S.C. or equivalent examination (for BCA and BMS) and B.Sc. (for M.Sc. - Computer Science), academic performance as specified by the management of the college.
- c. The annual family income of the student should be below the threshold set by the scholarship or free-ship provider.
- d. The student should not be receiving any other substantial fee concession from any government or non-government sources simultaneously unless permitted by the provider.
- e. The student must adhere to college attendance, discipline, and conduct policies.

3. Scope and Extent of Concession:

- a. The fee concession may cover to the students admitted in First Year of B.C.A., B.M.S., and M.Sc. (Computer Science) who have secured above 60% marks in H.S.C (for BCA and BMS) and B.Sc. (for M.Sc. - Computer Science) examinations are eligible to get the free-ship.
- b. The amount of Scholarship for BCA and BMS students is Rs. 2000/- and for M.Sc. (Computer Science) students is Rs. 3000/-

4. Disbursement of Fee Concessions:

- a. The fee concession will be directly applied to the student's fee account, reducing the payable amount accordingly.
- b. Students will be notified in writing about the fee concession awarded to them.

5. Monitoring and Accountability:

The college will maintain records of all students awarded fee concessions and monitor their academic progress.

6. Grievance Redressal System:

- a. Any grievances related to the fee concession process should be submitted in writing to the Scholarship and Free-ship Committee.
- b. The committee will address and resolve grievances within a stipulated time frame.

7. Policy Amendments:

- a. The college reserves the right to amend this policy as necessary, in consultation with the scholarship or free-ship provider.
- b. Any amendments will be communicated to the students via the college notice board and website.
