For the academic year 2022-2023 feedback was collected from students, parents, teachers, alumni and employer during the month of January and February, the collected feedback was analysed by feedback cell and submitted report to IQAC.

Based on discussion made on feedback analysis report 2022-2023 at IQAC meeting is held on 07 March 2023 following actions were taken: -

Feedback On Curriculum	
Issues	Action Taken
From the analysis of all the stackholders's feedback it is found that the curriculum is not job oriented.	Experts from industry were invited to deliver sessions to enhance industry based knowledge and entrepreneurship skills. Emerging career avenues addressed.
To have more pre-placement sessions for appearing to campus interview.	Placement training enhanced to develop resume writing skills, communication skills, etc.
The faculty members should adopt case study technique/ assignments/ hands on training to enhance current trends and skillset.	Faculty members have included a multiprong approach focusing upon the recent trends by giving assignments based training studies to gain insights of current industry scenario
More personal development training can be given to students to equip them to face the challenges in industry	Organized personal development training/skill training program "Finishing Touch" to final year students by Rubicon Skill Development Pvt Ltd.
From the analysis of feedback from students it is observed syllabus of some subjects is not completed in given time.	Extra and online classes arranged to complete the entire syllabus.
To enhance time management skills and foster student participation in sports and extracurricular activities.	Reported to HOD and informed in the Academic Council. More extracurricular activities and games are provided with the support of Physical education Department.



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Industry oriented training needed, apart from addition to syllabus, revision by way of deletion of outdated contents.	Industry oriented training provided to the students with the help of outside agencies. Communication send through mail to university after discussing with HOD and Principal.
According to the analysis of feedback on alumni and employer we found that communication skill is lacking in our institute's students.	Students are instructed to communicate in English Language with their peers and faculty members while in the campus and usage of English language lab is mandatory to all students.
More focus towards industry interactions.	Organized industrial visits and sessions on industry interactions to students.
Encourage the students to participate in extra and co-curricular activities	Discussed in the Department meeting and the class teachers were instructed to students to ensure active participation of students in all the activities of the college.
There is a need for increased encouragement towards research projects among students.	With the supervision of faculty members, students could publish their research articles in various reputed journals.
There were also calls for improvement in washroom hygiene in both student and staff toilets.	It is noted and reported to concern sanitation committee and asked them to clean toilets twice a day.
More Focus needed for research related projects.	Discussed in the Department meeting and gave research based assignments and presentations.
Some concerns are raised regarding the internet connectivity and student-computer ratio in the college.	The internet bandwidth coverage of the college has improved. New and upgraded computers are added in the computer lab. Functional computers and projectors are installed in all
