The session was thoroughly informative for students as well as faculty members.

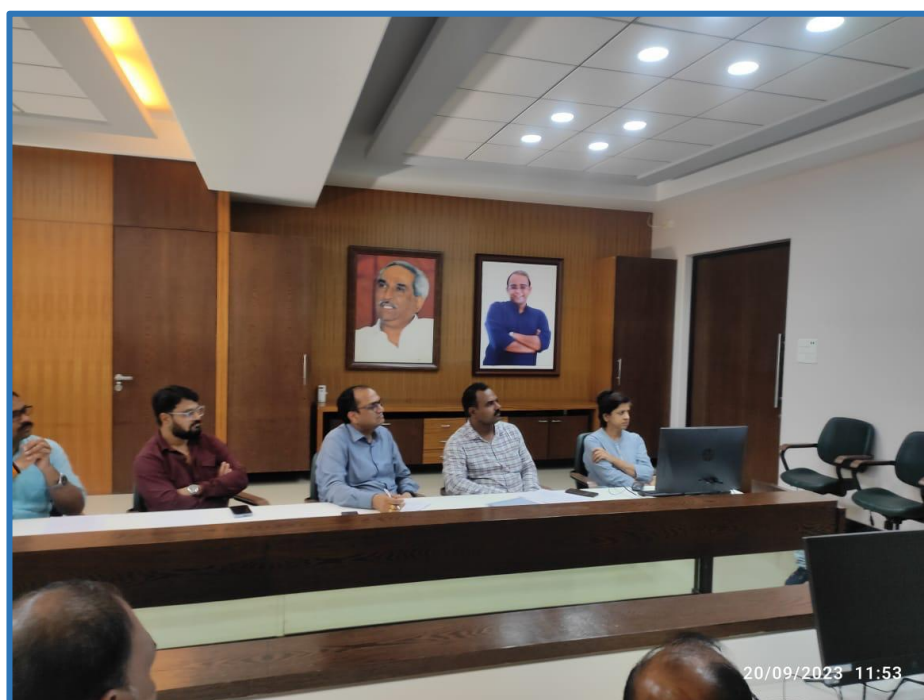

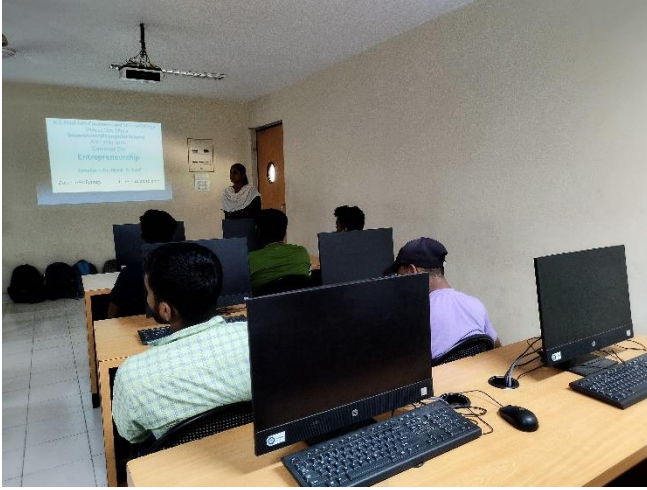
