





#### 1.4 College Site Plan Map:






**Institute Ground Floor Plan**




### 8.5 Electricity/ Power Supply Back-up Provisions

The college relies on two diesel power supply generators and solar panels (off-grid and on) to cover its emergency electrical needs. The college's first generator is close to the botanical garden, while the second is situated between the drinking water facility and the girls' common area. Each of the generators generates and supplies 15 kW of electricity. On the main building's terrace are 63 solar panels in total. The output/electricity produced by these solar panels is 15 kW and 5 kW apiece.






