

The idea behind the tree plantation activity was to propagate the message that planting the trees helps to maintain clear eco-friendly environment reduces pollution and improves the green ambience. The Tree Plantation drive is aimed at combating many environmental issues like deforestation, erosion of soil, global warming and hence enhancing the beauty and balance of the environment. On background of pandemic situation of COVID-19, alumni decided to do tree plantation program at their own place i.e. nearby area of their home by following all COVID-19 measures guidelines provided by Govt. Keeping all provided instruction in mind total 20 volunteers done tree plantation in nearby area of their house and plant one sapling each, total 18 saplings are planted.
