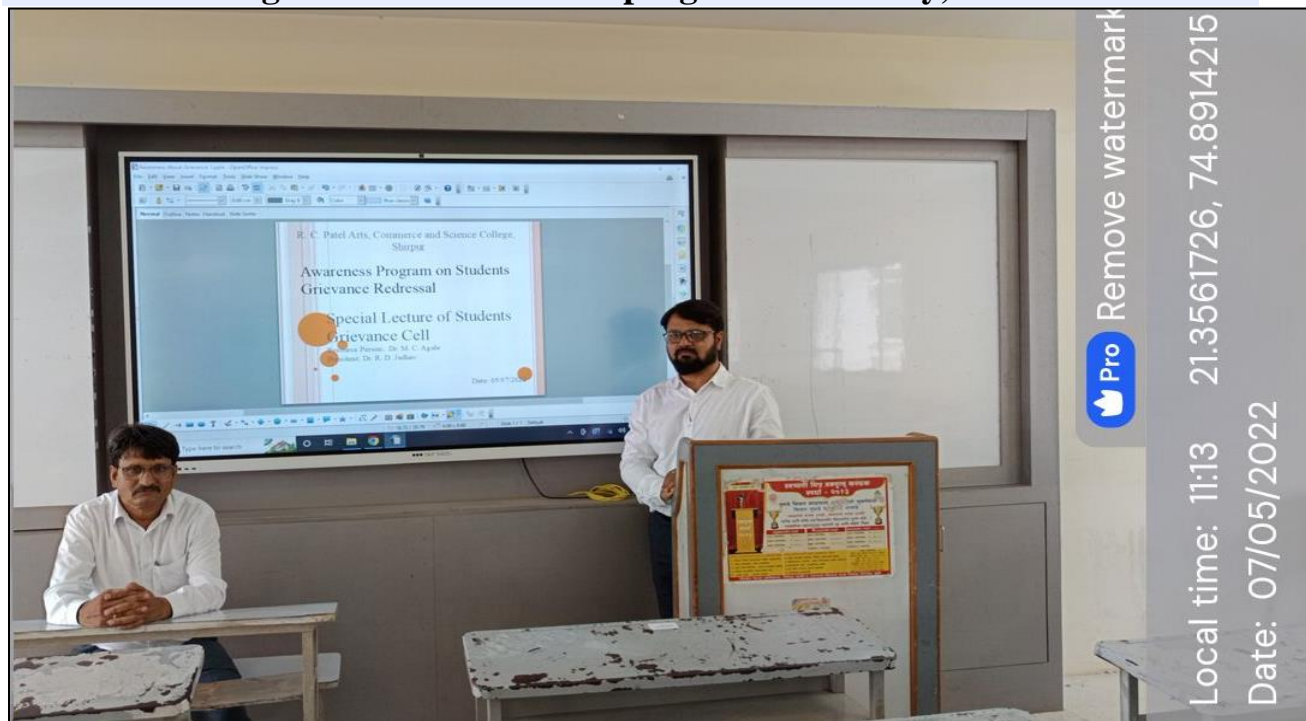

Students' Grievance and Redressal Cell, R. C. Patel ACS College, Shirpur organized an Awareness program on 5th July, 2022

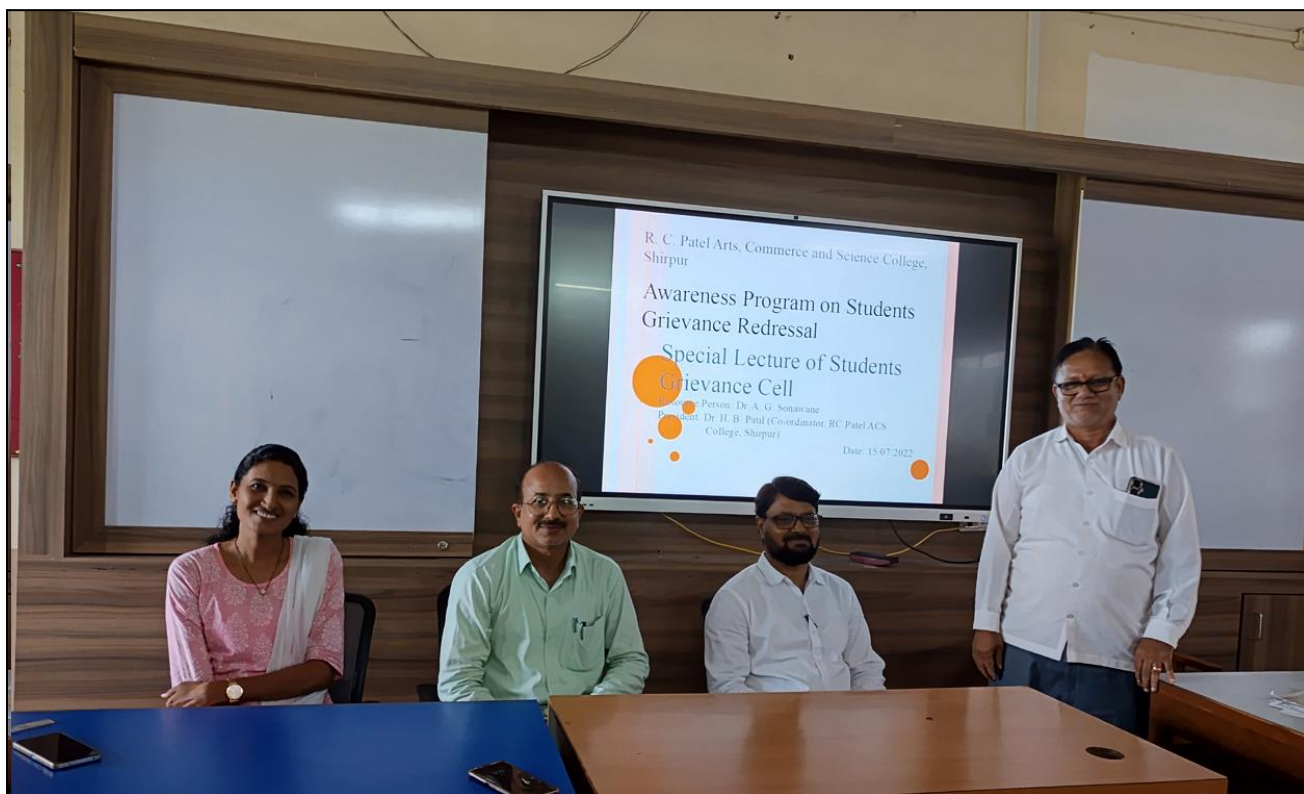


Dr. M. C. Aagale Addressing Students in awareness program organised on 05 July 2022

7. **Positive Campus Culture:** An effective grievance redressal system and awareness program contribute to a positive campus culture where students feel supported, valued, and heard.



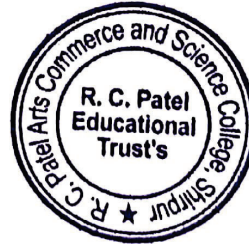
Report of the Student Grievance Redressal Committee Academic Year 2022-2023
