Vote of thanks was proposed by Mr.J.P.Sonawane, Asst. Prof. (RCPACS).


The last two speakers of the session were Dr.M.K.Patel and Dr. S.R.Patil around 2:00 pm.

Chart 1: Responses on the statement 'Workshop Objectives were stated clearly and met'






Chart 3: Responses on the statement 'This workshop was well organised'

<u>Chart 5: Responses on the statement 'The presenter(s) provided adequate time for questions and answered them satisfactorily.'</u>







Chart 6: Responses on the statement 'This workshop increased my knowledge and skills in developing Research Proposal.'

Report on

"Entrepreneurship Skill Development Camp" conducted by

Department Computer Application and Management Studies

The department of Computer Application and Management Studies organized a one day webinar on "Entrepreneurship Skill Development Camp" on 18/01/2021 using zoom platform for the students of department.

Objectives:

The aim of workshop is to make students aware about entrepreneurship and its skills, to encourage and motivate them for entrepreneurship, which will boost their inner urge for becoming self-employed in future, to be job creator rather than job seeker. Webinar will make students aware about entrepreneurial practices going on in corporate world that would be shared by young entrepreneurs and trainer.

The main attractions of the camp were as follows:

- Successful Entrepreneurs were invited for expert lecture.
- Practicing entrepreneur's success stories common problems faced by entrepreneurs was discussed.
- Grant, funding and loaning from banks, agencies was discussed.
- Improving communication skills (interacting with people) for better results was discussed.

Asst. Prof. A.V. Jagtap of I BCA welcomed the gathering. Program Coordinator Dr. Anita More Assistant Professor, Department of Computer application & Management gave a brief introduction about the programme. The Programme was inaugurated by Dr. D. R. Patil, Principal R. C. Patel ACS College, and Shirpur.

In this webinar we highlighted the importance of self-employment, qualities and the skills required to be an entrepreneur. We also explained the various core entrepreneurial skills by making them to participate in mind related games. Live stories of the entrepreneurs were narrated, challenges faced by them and how they overcame the hurdles and became successful entrepreneurs were discussed.

The programme sensitized the students to inculcate entrepreneurial ideas & motivated them to take up an entrepreneurial journey in future. The program was quite informative and interesting too. The programme concluded with a vote of thanks by **Mr. Gopal K. Bide.**

Session 1:

Prof. A. G. Sonawane addressed the participants. They explained difference between Businessman and Entrepreneur with examples. Both spoke why it is important to be innovative for an entrepreneur. Activities were conducted to help the participant's network with each other and the importance of that was highlighted to the participants.

Session 2:

Dr. Manoj Patil addressed the students and spoke about Jugaad and creativity in solving real life problems. The speakers gave opportunity to interact during session and explained them how entrepreneurs think before arriving at a solution to a problem they have identified. Session was dealt using many examples with videos.

Session 3:

The speaker of session Mr. Rahul Mali shared her entrepreneurship journey and explained how entrepreneurs see a problem as an opportunity for business. The speaker showed some videos related to the topic and she spoke about her startup and challenges she faced as an entrepreneur. He also addressed the participants on ideation process and selecting best idea to build products or services. He talked about how design thinking process can help entrepreneurs to get clear picture of the problem they identified and how to convert that into viable business idea. He shared examples of startup founders who used this method to address their challenges in business.

Session 4: The camp ended with QA session and followed by Feedback session.

INTELECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTs (IPRs)

FRIDAY, 10th APRIL 2021

Background

Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) are a set of legally protected exclusive rights granted to authors or individuals over their creations for a fixed length of time. An IP property holder can derive value from its intellectual assets by using them internally for internal activities or by sharing them outside by providing goods and services to customers. The latter is possible through legal means such as licence or assignment.

Intellectual property has risen to prominence in the context of economic growth in today's internationally competitive world, and it is becoming increasingly vital. Intellectual property (IP) is the engine that drives prosperity, encouraging creation and innovation. The growing importance of intangible assets in the global economy is compelling commercial organisations to actively manage their intellectual property (IP) as a major driver for establishing and maintaining a competitive edge and attaining better performance.

IPRs are today employed not only to protect creativity and earn cash, but also to create strategic partnerships for socioeconomic and technical advancement. As a result, the Intellectual Property Office under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry is dedicated to mobilising the use of such technological improvement for the country's economic development in order to support the protection of innovations and creativity.

Objectives

An R.C.Patel Arts, Commerce and Science College, through Research Committee has conducted a One Day Workshop on Intellectual Property Right (IPR) for the task of creating awareness about Intellectual Property Rights amongst faculty and post graduate students.

Inaugural function

The workshop was inaugurated by the hands of Hon. Principal Dr. Dilip R. Patil. Mr. B.S. Panchabhai (Coordinator), Dr.Rahul Kulkarni (Assist. Prof. Department of commerce, A.C.S. College, Chalisgaon) were the chief guests of the inaugural function. Introductory speech was delivered by Dr. B.S.Panchabhai (Coordinator). It was followed by the speech of Dr. D. R. Patil. Words of thanks were presented by Dr. R. H. Patil (Member, College Research Committee).

Session I

The inaugural function was followed by the talk of Dr. Rahul Kulkarni on the topic "Intellectual Property Right (IPR)". The first session focused primarily on conceptual discussions and clarifications on IPR and then the need and significance of patent filling and related processes. It was significant information for the students. About 107 students have attended the session.

Session II

A beautiful talk on Research Methodology was delivered by Principal Dr. D. R. Patil (R. C. Patel A. C. S. College, Shirpur). He explains patentability assessment and the efforts being carried out by IPO for registration of IPRs. Throughout the presentation she gives many examples on what to be filed for patent. Finally explaining the process of filing the Patent application, Copyright application, Trademark application, Design application and the Scheme for Facilitating Start-ups Intellectual Property Protection. Role and view of IPO in granting any patent was presented in the concluding remarks followed by question answer session.
